3rd Notice of Teaching Arrangement for the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2021/2022

**This notice is very important for all undergraduate students.
Please read it immediately and carefully!**

Dear Undergraduate Students,

We would like to announce that all teaching activities can resume normal and classes will mainly be arranged on a face-to-face teaching basis from **15 September 2021**. Please find below the detailed teaching arrangements for the 1st semester of academic year 2021/2022:

1. University Almanac and Important Dates

2. Teaching Mode

All classes will mainly be arranged on a **face-to-face teaching basis** from **15 September 2021**. Students should pay close attention to the Announcement of the Special Webpage against Epidemics of the Health Bureau of the Macao SAR (<https://www.ssm.gov.mo/apps1/PreventCOVID-19/en.aspx#clg17610>).

Further to the advice from the Education and Youth Development Bureau, **students must return to their residence in Macao SAR, Zhuhai or Zhongshan 14 days before they resume classes in Macao for self-health management**. Students may refer to the Technical Guidelines announced by the Centre for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on 23 December 2020 (<https://www.ssm.gov.mo/apps1/PreventCOVID-19/en.aspx#clg17668> → Personal Preventive Measures → Precautions for Self-Health Management). Students who are currently in Macao SAR, Zhuhai or Zhongshan are also advised to follow the above-mentioned Technical Guidelines for self-health management during the same period.

For students or their housemates who have ever been to areas outside Macao SAR, Zhuhai or Zhongshan after 6 August 2021, they must:

- **complete the nucleic acid test within 5 days before the start of face-to-face classes; and**
- **present the health code with negative nucleic acid test result when returning to the campus for study.**

If students are **NOT permitted to enter Macao by the Macao SAR Government**, the University will arrange online classes for these students.

Students are required to attend the face-to-face classes on campus during the classroom teaching period and the requirement of 80% class attendance on the said period will be applied as normal.	These students' class attendance will not be considered but they will still be required to meet the participation requirements advised by the teachers concerned.

3. Teaching Materials

All teaching materials, e.g. teaching videos, PPT, etc. are owned by the University and the teachers. Students are **NOT** allowed to share or upload any of them on social media, such as YouTube, WeChat, etc., and other electronic platforms.

4. Preparation for Classes

5. Project-based, Internship, Laboratory, Physical Education and Activity Courses

It is understood that some international students cannot attend face-to-face classroom learning due to entry restriction of Macao SAR. Some courses such as project-based, internship, laboratory, physical education, etc. require students' participation and it will be difficult to take these courses online. Therefore, when this happens and if this is not your final year of study, we advise you to take these courses in the 2nd semester or after until you can return to the campus for classroom learning. If this is your final year of study, you are advised to consult the department heads and programme coordinators of your faculty concerned for detailed arrangement of these courses.

7. Avoid Travelling

Travelling to and from different countries/regions is a risk factor for COVID-19, so it is important to consider carefully the necessity of the trip. Online classes will **NOT** be arranged for students who undergo mandatory isolation or medical observation resulted from travelling.

Students are reminded to wear a mask, wash hands frequently, keep a distance and avoid crowd gathering. The University is closely monitoring the situation of COVID-19 and will make necessary adjustments to the teaching arrangement in accordance with the announcements and prevention guidelines of the Macao SAR Government.
