# New Arrangement for Pre-enrolment in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester of Academic Year 2020/2021 (Applicable for All Undergraduate Students except for the Faculty of Law Students)

Dear Undergraduate Students,

The pre-enrolment for the  $2^{nd}$  semester of academic year 2020/2021 is scheduled on 20-26 October 2020 and we would like to inform you that we are going to pre-assign the Compulsory Major (major CM) courses for you with details as follows:

#### 1. List of Major CM Courses to be Pre-assigned in Pre-enrolment

The list of major CM courses will be read in accordance with student's study plan and his/her enrolment records subject to the availability of teaching resources. Simply speaking, a student will have all of his/her required-to-be-completed major CM courses pre-assigned in pre-enrolment if he/she fulfils the pre-requisite requirements and the course settings defined by the course offering units.

Example: A student pre-enrols as a year-2 ACC19 student with 5 major CM courses need to be completed will have the following pre-assignment.

List of Major CM Courses to be Pre-assigned	Pre-requisite Requirement	Course Setting	Remarks
A	Nil	ACC19 students at year 1 or above	Course A will be pre-assigned.
В	Nil	ACC19 students at year 3 or above	Course B will <b>not</b> be pre-assigned.
С	C1 (completed)	GBS17 students at year 1 or above	Course C will <b>not</b> be pre-assigned.
D	D1 (completed) + D2 (completed)	ACC19 students at year 2 or above	Course D will be pre-assigned.
Е	E1 (not completed)	ACC19 students at year 1 or above	Course E will <b>not</b> be pre-assigned.



### 2. Assumption for the Courses Enrolled in the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2020/2021

The courses students enrol in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of academic year 2020/2021 will be considered as "completed" during pre-enrolment and course add/drop until the final results are confirmed. Example: Taking the above example on courses A and D.

List of Major CM Courses to be Pre-assigned	Pre-requisite Requirement	Course Setting	Remarks
A	Nil	ACC19 students at year 1 or above	Course A will be pre-assigned.
D	D1 (completed) + D2 (enrolled in 1st semester of academic year 2020/2021 without final results confirmed)	ACC19 students at year 2 or above	Course D will be pre-assigned.

### 3. Major CM Courses being Withdrawn in the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2020/2021

The major CM courses that have been withdrawn in the  $1^{\rm st}$  semester of academic year 2020/2021 will be considered as "not completed" and they will not be pre-assigned during pre-enrolment. Students who wish to enrol the courses again in the  $2^{\rm nd}$  semester will be required to pre-enrol on their own.

Example: Taking the above example on courses A, D and a withdrawn major CM course F.

List of Major CM Courses to be Pre-assigned	Pre-requisite Requirement	Course Setting	Remarks
A	Nil	ACC19 students at year 1 or above	Course A will be pre-assigned.
D	D1 (completed) + D2 (enrolled in 1st semester of academic year 2020/2021 without final results confirmed)	ACC19 students at year 2 or above	Course D will be pre-assigned.
Withdrawn Major CM Course F	Nil	All major students	Course F will <b>not</b> be pre-assigned.



#### 4. Course Load

In case a student's pre-assigned major CM courses exceed his/her maximum course load, his/her home faculty will provide academic advice and confirm the major CM courses to be pre-assigned to the student.

Example: A student on Academic Probation (AP) can only enrol in a maximum of 12 credits of courses. In case the student has 5 major CM courses to be pre-assigned, his/her home faculty will advise which 4 major CM courses to be pre-assigned to him/her.

### 5. Pre-assignment Setting

Students will not be allowed to delete any of the pre-assigned major CM courses during pre-enrolment. However, though it is not suggested, students can drop the pre-assigned major CM courses during course add/drop.
