- 1.5 Offer and Admission process
  - 1.5.4 Assessment of admission will only be made on the academic documents submitted along with the on-line application. Admission selection will be based on the applicant's choices of programmes, admission quotas and interview (when applicable).
  - 1.5.5 Offer results will be released via the On-line Application System. Notification email and SMS will be sent to candidates. The admission result released is the final academic decision of the application.
  - 1.5.6 Candidates should follow the admission procedure as stipulated in the On-line Application System and the offer letter to confirm acceptance. Offered candidates must settle the non-refundable tuition fee of 1<sup>st</sup> semester listed on the debit note for payment. If candidates fail to confirm acceptance and settle the fees within the prescribed period as printed on the offer letter, the offer of admission will be cancelled. All fees are non-refundable.
  - 1.5.7 Offer candidates will be requested to provide certified true copies of documents stated in the "Offer of Admission" during the registration period. Candidates may choose to submit originals of documents requested, or present the originals and copies for certification by the Registry. Offer candidates who fail to provide the original of the required documents for verification and complete new student registration within specific period will be disqualified from admission and subsequent enrolment in the University.
