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Principals' Recommended Admission (PRA) Rules 2019/2020

1. Introduction

As the primary comprehensive university in the region, the University of Macau (UM) is committed to fostering local high quality and well-round talents as our mission. To this end, the **“Principals' Recommended Admission Scheme”** is established to allow local secondary schools to recommend outstanding students for direct admission and all qualified students will be granted different types of scholarship. Effective from 2019/2020, in order to extend admission opportunities for students with diverse talents, two additional schemes are devised under the scope of current Principals' Recommended Schemes – namely the **“Chinese and Portuguese Bilingual Talent Nurturing Scheme”** and **“Outstanding Student-Athletes Admission Scheme”**. The former aims to cultivate outstanding local Chinese and Portuguese talents for Macao S.A.R. while the latter encourages local student-athletes to pursue higher academic qualifications and to continue to make breakthrough in their sports talents.

3. Application Procedures and Documents

3.1 Online Application System

Recommended applicants must submit an on-line application for Principals' Recommended Admission together with all required documents within the application period of **24/09 – 12/10/2018**. (Please refer to the “User Manual of Online Application System for Principals' Recommended Admission 2019/2020”).

3.2 Recommended applicants need to scan and upload the following documents on to the system:

- 3.2.1 Valid Macao I.D. card (both sides on one A4 size paper);
- 3.2.2 One passport size color photo (white background is preferred);
- 3.2.3 Official transcript of academic records for the recent two years (Form 4 to Form 5) of secondary education (A4 size);



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- 3.2.4 Related certificates or proof for supplementary information of special talents, awards or community service (A4 size) (if applicable);
- 3.2.5 Applicants for “**Chinese and Portuguese Bilingual Talent Nurturing Scheme**” must additionally provide related certificates or proof for proficiency of CIPLE Level A2 (Certificado Inicial de Português Língua Estrangeira) or equivalent (A4 size); if such proof is not available, a declaration to support applicants’ equivalent level of proficiency provided by the school is accepted.
- 3.2.6 Applicants for “**Outstanding Student-Athletes Admission Scheme**” must additionally provide related certificates or proof of representing Macao S.A.R. to participate in international/regional sports competition within the last two years, or a written recommendation from sports association (A4 size).
- 3.3 Interview will be conducted for qualified applicants.

4. Successful Applicants

4.1 Scholarship for “Principals’ Recommended Admission 2019/2020”

- 4.1.1 All applicants admitted to Bachelor’s degree programme through “Principals’ Recommended Admission 2019/2020” will be granted scholarship. There are four types of scholarships: “University of Macau Grand Lotus Scholarship”, “University of Macau Golden Lotus Scholarship”, “University of Macau Silver Lotus Scholarship” and “University of Macau First Year Scholarship”.

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- 4.1.2 For students to be admitted through **“Principals’ Recommended Admission Scheme”** and **“Chinese and Portuguese Bilingual Talent Nurturing Scheme”**, assessment of will take the following factors into account: students’ school performance, ranking, academic and non-academic talents, community service and interview. Among four types of scholarship, the “University of Macau Grand Lotus Scholarship” is established to award students of the most outstanding talents or extraordinary achievement. The scholarship selection is very competitive while our Faculty Deans will recommend their best offered students to the Committee of “University of Macau Grand Lotus Scholarship” for most competent recipients.
- 4.1.3 Students must stay in Residential College for the 1st academic year as to enjoy the full waiver of Residential College fee for “University of Macau Grand Lotus Scholarship” recipients. If students do not stay in Residential College during the study period, the full waiver of the fee will not be granted. Students should comply with all the Residential College’s rules during the stay in Residential College.
- 4.1.4 For students to be admitted through **“Outstanding Student-Athletes Admission Scheme”**, assessment of admission will base on applicants’ sports achievements together with the interview while the final selection will be made by the Committee of this scheme to the most competent recipients.
- 4.1.5 For the continuation scheme of University of Macau Lotus Scholarship (inclusive of Grand Lotus, Golden Lotus and Silver Lotus Scholarship), please refer to point 9 and 10 for “Continuation Rules of University of Macau Lotus Scholarship for Principals’ Recommended Admission 2019/2020”. “University of Macau First Year Scholarship” is however not renewable, the scholarship amount will be used to offset part of the tuition fees payable for the 1st and 2nd semester of 2019/2020 (MOP 5,000 for each semester).
- 4.2 Successful applicants are not permitted to change their programmes of study once their offer confirmations have been submitted to the University.



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- 4.3 If a successful applicant accepts our offer of admission (returning the “Statement of Acceptance”), he/she is not permitted to apply for admission to the Bachelor’s degree programmes of the University by other channels. If he/she is found to be admitted through other channels, the University reserves the rights to cancel his/her admission qualifications.
- 4.4 If a successful applicant defers study, the University reserves the rights to terminate the scholarship qualification (inclusive of tuition fee waiver, Residential College fee waiver and related eligibility).
- 4.5 All students admitted through the Principals’ Recommended Admission Scheme will follow the general rules related to admission of bachelor’s degree programmes. Please visit the website at <https://reg.um.edu.mo/admission/> for details.
- 4.6 Upon admission, scholarship recipients of “Principals’ Recommended Admission Scheme” and “Chinese and Portuguese Bilingual Talent Nurturing Scheme” are obliged to participate and assist in any university activities which aim to cultivate students’ sense of community service and their practical competence during the undergraduate study.
- 4.7 Upon admission, scholarship recipients of “Outstanding Student-Athletes Admission Scheme” are obliged to participate and assist in any university sports activities and represent UM to participate in any sports competitions during the undergraduate study.

5. Unsuccessful Applicants

Unsuccessful applicants may apply for the Joint Admission Examination for Macao Four Higher Education Institutions (JAE) for admission to the Bachelor’s degree programmes of the University.

8. Disqualification of Application, Admission or Study

8.1 The University reserves the rights to reject any applications from students beyond the top 10% in terms of academic performance in their Form 5/Grade 11/Senior Middle 2 study.

8.2 Applicants must guarantee that the information given in the application form is TRUE. The University of Macau reserves the rights to terminate an application, admission or study at any time if :

- any information given in his/her application form is found later to be untrue and/or incorrect;
- an applicant offered with admission is found to have violated any of the regulations of the University of Macau or misconduct behavior.

Should such cases occur, any fees paid will not be refunded.



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8.3 Registered students of University of Macau cannot concurrently register/enrol in any other higher education programme(s) in Macao, including the programme(s) offered by the University of Macau. If students are found to be registered for more than one higher education programme, the University of Macau reserves the rights to terminate his/her application or study at any time.

9. Continuation Rules of University of Macau Lotus Scholarship 2019/2020 (for students admitted through “Principals’ Recommended Admission Scheme” and “Chinese and Portuguese Bilingual Talent Nurturing Scheme”)

9.1 Qualifications

- 9.1.1 All students granted with the University of Macau Lotus Scholarship, subject to their yearly academic performance, can continue enjoying half or full tuition fee waiver during 2nd to 4th academic year of study (during 2nd to 5th academic year of study for Bachelor of Law five-year programmes);
- 9.1.2 Scholarship candidates must achieve satisfactory results in their previous academic year of study as to continue the eligibility of scholarship. Evaluation is based on each academic year’s performance (yearly GPA) but not cumulative performance (such as cumulative GPA);
- 9.1.3 Bachelor’s degree students must have passed at least 24 credits for each academic year.

9.3 Termination of Scholarship

9.3.1 The University reserves the rights to terminate the scholarship (inclusive of tuition fee waiver, Residential College fee waiver and related eligibility) if a student:

- 9.3.1.1 cannot achieve the academic year's performance mentioned above;
- 9.3.1.2 cannot complete his/her study within the normal period of study;
- 9.3.1.3 changes faculties/programmes;
- 9.3.1.4 defers his/her study;
- 9.3.1.5 cannot achieve the Residential College requirements.

9.3.2 Please refer to point 4 for details of Lotus Scholarship.

10. Continuation Rules of University of Macau Lotus Scholarship 2019/2020 (for students admitted through "Outstanding Student-Athletes Admission Scheme")

10.1 Current students admitted through "Outstanding Student-Athletes Admission Scheme"



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may continue to enjoy such scholarship in the 2nd academic year to normal period of study subjected to their academic performances, sports achievements, stay in the Residential College and meeting the related requirements.

- 10.2 Scholarship recipients must meet the academic requirements of yearly GPA no less than 2.0 in their previous academic year of study (For students studying in the Bachelor of Law programme, the yearly scales must not be less than 10 out of 20), and fulfill 80% of attendance rate of their related UM Sports Team regular training and participate in competitions.
- 10.3 Scholarship recipients must stay in the Residential College and comply with all the related requirement for the continuation of the scholarship within the normal period of study.
- 10.4 Positive attitude and active participation in all sports team related events.
- 10.5 The University reserves the rights to terminate the scholarship (inclusive of tuition fee waiver, Residential College fee waiver and related eligibility) if a student:
 - 10.5.1 cannot achieve the academic year's performance mentioned above;
 - 10.5.2 cannot complete his/her study within the normal period of study;
 - 10.5.3 changes faculties/programmes;
 - 10.5.4 defers his/her study;
 - 10.5.5 does not stay in Residential College and does not meet the requirement of the Residential College;
 - 10.5.6 does not meet the requirement of his/her related UM Sports Team's training and competition.

3 申請手續及文件

3.1 獲推薦學生必須於報名日期 **2018 年 9 月 24 日至 10 月 12 日** 內登入校長推薦入學網上報名系統填寫並遞交申請表格及相關資料（請查閱「2019/2020 學年校長推薦入學網上報名系統使用手冊」）。

3.2 獲推薦學生必須上載下列文件至網上報名系統：

- 3.2.1 有效之澳門居民身份證副本一張（正反兩面複印於同一版 A4 尺寸的紙上）；
- 3.2.2 彩色近照一張（約 3.5 厘米 X 4.5 厘米，建議相片採用白色背景）；
- 3.2.3 中學最近兩年成績表（即高中一及高中二年級成績）（A4 紙尺寸）；
- 3.2.4 特別才能或傑出貢獻者之獲獎證書及社會服務之相關證明（A4 紙尺寸）（如適用）；
- 3.2.5 申請「**葡語專才推薦計劃**」者請另行提交初級葡語水準 A2 水平（CIPLE - Certificado Inicial de Português Língua Estrangeira Level 2）或同等水平之認證（A4 紙尺寸）；如申請人於報名時未能提交有關證明，可由所屬中學提交聲明說明其葡語能力已達相關水平。
- 3.2.6 申請「**傑出運動員推薦計劃**」者請另行提交最近兩年代表澳門參加國際性／地區性比賽相關證明或獲獎證書或體育總會推薦書（A4 紙尺寸）。

4 錄取生

- 4.1.2 經「校長推薦入學計劃」及「葡語專才推薦計劃」錄取之標準為綜合學生校內學習表現、成績排名、學術或非學術類之特別才能、社會服務及面試表現等各方面因素考量。其中「澳門大學大蓮花獎學金」之設立為表彰具特別卓越才能及貢獻的優秀學生，其遴選由本校各學院院長推薦其獲錄取最優秀學生予「澳門大學大蓮花獎學金」評審委員會審批，擇優頒發。
- 4.1.3 有關「澳門大學大蓮花獎學金」之住宿式書院費用豁免，學生於入讀首學年入住書院方可享用，如學生在讀期間不住書院，將不獲該項全額書院費用豁免。學生入住書院期間必須遵守住宿式書院有關規定。
- 4.1.4 經「傑出運動員推薦計劃」錄取之標準是按申請人所獲得之運動比賽成績及面試而定，並由本校「傑出運動員推薦計劃」入學評審委員會審批，擇優頒發。
- 4.1.5 「澳門大學蓮花獎學金」(包括大蓮花、金蓮花及銀蓮花獎學金)皆可延續，有關規條請查閱第9及10點之「2019/2020學年澳門大學蓮花獎學金延續規條」。而「澳門大學首年級獎學金」只限於學生註冊入讀之第一學年發放，有關獎學金會於2019/2020學年第一及第二學期的學費中扣除(即每學期扣除澳門幣伍仟元)。
- 4.2 獲錄取之學生不可更改課程。
- 4.3 獲錄取之學生確認接受本校入學資格後(即交回「入學聲明書」予本校註冊處)，不可從其他入學途徑申請報讀本校之學士學位課程。如被發現以其他途徑入學，本校有權取消其錄取資格。
- 4.4 獲錄取之學生如保留學位，本校有權取消其獎學金資格(包括學費、住宿式書院費用之豁免及相關津貼)。

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8 申請、入學及學籍資格之取消

- 8.1 本校有權不接受於中學五年級／十一年級／高中二年級成績名列最優秀學生百分之十以外之申請。
- 8.2 申請人須確保申請表內填寫及遞交資料全部屬實。如有不實填報及／或填報不正確資料，或獲錄取之學生於入學註冊前觸犯了本校任何規則或被發現有任何不當行為，本校有權取消申請人之申請、入學及學籍資格；其所遞交予本校之文件及已繳之費用將不予退回。
- 8.3 作為澳門大學之註冊學生，不得同時在本澳其他高等教育課程註冊及選科，其中包括澳門大學所開辦的課程。如有此等事件發生，學生必須向有關教育機構如實申報，而澳門大學亦有權終止申請人之申請及學籍等資格。

9 2019/2020 學年「澳門大學蓮花獎學金」延續規條（適用於所有經「校長推薦入學計劃」及「葡語專才推薦計劃」入學學生）

9.1 資格

- 9.1.1 凡獲「澳門大學蓮花獎學金」的在讀學生可根據校內學業成績於第二至四學年享有半額或全額之學費減免（而法學士學位五年制之課程則根據校內成績繼續於第二至五學年享有半額或全額之學費減免）；
- 9.1.2 於上學年須獲得良好的學業成績，評核標準是基於每學年成績的平均績點，而不是累積成績的績點；
- 9.1.3 學士學位課程的學生必須每學年至少合格完成 24 個學分。

10 2019/2020 學年「澳門大學蓮花獎學金」延續規條（適用於經「傑出運動員推薦計劃」入學學生）

10.1 凡經「傑出運動員推薦計劃」入學的在讀學生可根據校內學業成績、運動成就、入住並達到住宿式書院之要求於第二至正常學習年限繼續享有與首學年相同之獎學金；

10.2 於上學年學生之學業成績須達平均績點 2.0 或以上（而法學士學位之學生每學年需達二十分制之十分或以上），並且必須參與校隊的訓練（出席率達 80% 或以上）及代表澳門大學參加各類型運動賽事；

10.3 於正常學習年限內延續獎學金，必須入住及遵守住宿式書院之要求。

10.4 積極參與所有體育校隊活動。

10.5 本校有權終止頒發獎學金（包括學費、住宿式書院費用之豁免及相關津貼），如學生：

- 10.5.1 未達到上述學年學業成績之規定；
- 10.5.2 未能於正常學習年限內完成學業；
- 10.5.3 轉學院／課程；
- 10.5.4 保留學位；
- 10.5.5 未有入住及達到「住宿式書院要求」；
- 10.5.6 未達到校隊訓練及比賽之要求。
