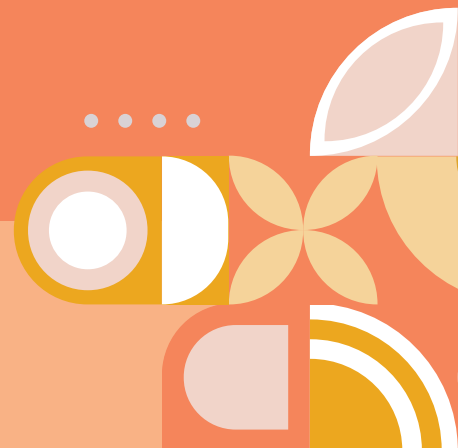

Application period

30th January – 5th April 2024

Target students

- Macao and non-Macao student (not applicable to Mainland China students)
- Currently enrolled in / Successfully completed Form 6 or equivalent
- Must have met the below application requirements and upload all the required documents including personal identification document and academic documents during the application period.

Offer process

Assessment of admission will only be made on the academic documents submitted along with the on-line application. Admission selection will be based on the applicant's choices of programmes, admission quotas and interview (when applicable).



Application Qualifications and Requirements

Public Examinations / Qualifications

- **GCE A-Level:**
Grade E in 3 Advanced Level subjects; and
 - Not including English / Chinese subject
 - For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, Physics must be included
 - For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, Chemistry must be included.
- **SAT:** Score at 1190 or above
- **ACT:** Composite score at 24 or above
- **IB Diploma:** Successfully completed the IB Diploma programme curriculum and awarded the diploma
- **Canadian Secondary School Qualifications:**
 - Submit an official offer letter for bachelor programme of current year issued by a non-local higher education institution
- **Hong Kong DSE**
Obtained the following results in HKDSE in one sitting:
 - Level 3 or above in English Language; and
 - Level 3 or above in Chinese Language; and
 - Level 2 or above in Mathematics; and
 - “Attained” in Citizenship and Social Development; and
 - Level 3 or above in two elective subjects (Category A)
 - For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, elective subject of Physics must be included.
 - For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, elective subject of Chemistry must be included.
- **Taiwan General Scholastic Ability Test**
Obtained the following GSAT results in 4 subjects:
 - English subject result at “Good Standard” or above; and
 - Result in the other three subjects at “Average Standard” or above.
 - For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, the Mathematics subject at “Good Standard” or above.

Qualifications of admission to bachelor programme / currently enrolled a bachelor programme

- **Bachelor’s degree holder**
- **Currently enrolled in a bachelor programme in other higher education institution**
 - Submit official transcript and testimonial of current study
- **Potential graduate / holder of an associate degree or higher diploma**
 - Cumulative GPA must attain 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
