▶ Required academic documents

- Copies of certificate(s) and academic transcripts for Form 6 or equivalent in secondary school
- ◆ Copies of academic transcripts for the first semester of Form 6 or equivalent in secondary school
- ◆ If the Form 6 transcript is not available during the application period, candidates may submit the Form 5 transcript together with the page stating you are a current Form 6 student extracted from the DSEDJ student card (if applicable) or provide the testimonial to show currently enrolled Form 6.

Application Qualifications and Requirements

◆ GCE A-Level / IAL

Grade C or above in 3 Advanced Level subjects (not including English/Chinese)

- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, the above-mentioned subjects must include Physics.
- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, the above-mentioned subjects must include Chemistry.

◆ SAT & AP / ACT & AP

SAT score at 1,190 or above and two AP subjects with Grade 3 or above; or ACT composite score at 24 or above and two AP subjects with Grade 3 or above

- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, the above-mentioned AP subjects must include Physics.
- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, the above-mentioned AP subjects must include Chemistry.

◆ IB Diploma

Successfully completed the IB Diploma programme curriculum and awarded the diploma with 28 points or above.

- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, applicants must have obtained Higher Level (HL) Physics.
- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, applicants must have obtained Higher Level (HL) Chemistry.

◆ Canadian Secondary School Qualifications

Provincial High School Graduation Diploma with an average of 80% or above in five Grade 12 subjects (For OSSD requires 80% in six Grade 12 subjects)

- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, the above-mentioned Grade 12 subjects must include Physics.
- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, the above-mentioned Grade 12 subjects must include Chemistry.

◆ Mathayom Suksa 6, Thailand

◆ SMA Ijazah, Indonesia

◆ UEC / STPM, Malaysia

Passed in Grade C or above in at least 6 subjects in UEC; or Passed in Grade C or above in at least 3 subjects, other than language subject in STPM.

- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, the above-mentioned subjects must include Physics.
- ◆ For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, the above-mentioned subjects must include Chemistry.

◆ Hong Kong DSE

Obtained the following results in one sitting:

- ◆ Level 3 or above in English Language; and
- ◆ Level 3 or above in Chinese Language; and
- ◆ Level 2 or above in Mathematics; and
- ◆ “Attained” in Citizenship and Social Development; and
- ◆ Level 3 or above in two elective subjects of Category A
For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, elective subject of Physics must be included.
For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, elective subject of Chemistry must be included.

◆ Taiwan General Scholastic Ability Test

Obtained the following GSAT result in 4 subjects:

- ◆ English subject result at “Good Standard” or above; and
- ◆ Result in other three subjects at “Average Standard” or above.

◆ Bachelor’s degree holder

◆ Currently enrolled / had registered in a bachelor’s programme in other higher education institution

◆ Associate degree / higher diploma holder / potential graduate

Cumulative GPA must attain 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
