

### **Application Qualifications and Requirements**

#### GCE A-Level / IAL

Grade C or above in 3 Advanced Level subjects (not including English/Chinese)

- For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, the above-mentioned subjects must include Physics.
- For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, the abovementioned subjects must include Chemistry.

#### SAT & AP / ACT & AP

SAT score at 1,190 or above and two AP subjects with Grade 3 or above; or ACT composite score at 24 or above and two AP subjects with Grade 3 or above

- For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, the above-mentioned AP subjects must include Physics.
- For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, the abovementioned AP subjects must include Chemistry.

#### • IB Diploma

Successfully completed the IB Diploma programme curriculum and awarded the diploma with 28 points or above.

- For applicants to Faculty of Science and Technology, applicants must have obtained Higher Level (HL) Physics.
- For applicants to Faculty of Health Sciences, applicants must have obtained Higher Level (HL) Chemistry.
