# (Applicable for the Students being placed on IE1 level in Academic Year 2018/2019)

#### **Talk Time Tutorial**

- Talk Time tutorial is a one-year programme. It aims to provide additional and intensive speaking practice for the IE1 students.
- Students who are placed on IE1 upon admission will be required to take Talk Time alongside with EELC1001 in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and then alongside with EELC1002 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of their first year of studies.

#### 1st semester

EELC1001 – Interactive English I (3 credits, 6 lecture hours per week)

TELC1001 – Interactive English I (Talk Time) (non-credit bearing, 1 hour per week)

## 2<sup>nd</sup> semester

EELC1002 – Interactive English II (3 credits, 6 lecture hours per week)

TELC1002 – Interactive English II (Talk Time) (non-credit bearing, 1 hour per week)


- Talk Time will be required to be taken alongside with the repeating EELC1001 and EELC1002.
- Talk Time (TELC1001 and TELC1002) will not be graded nor shown on the academic transcript, however, talk time attendance is compulsory and connected to the final result of EELC1001 and EELC1002.

## **Co-requisite Requirement:**

## EELC1008 – Grammar & Writing Improvement 1 (3 credits, 3 lecture hours per week)

- The inclusion of EELC1008 aims to assist the low or underachieving EELC1001 students to successfully progress through EELC1002 to EELC1003.
- Students who obtain "D", "D+" or "C-" grade in EELC1001 will be required to take EELC1008 alongside with EELC1002.
- EELC1008 will be graded and shown on the academic transcript.
