

Notice – English Proficiency Test

Applicable to the Students admitted through Direct Admission in Academic Year 2024/2025 Except for Students of Bachelor of Law in Chinese Language (Daytime and Evening Programmes), Bachelor of Law (Conducted in Chinese and Portuguese Languages - Daytime Programme), Bachelor of Law in Portuguese Language (Evening Programme)

"Languages and Skills" is one of the components in the undergraduate curriculum model. It includes 0-9 credits of English language courses, 0-3 credits of Chinese or Portuguese language course, and 3 credits of Information Technology course. Please note that students are required to take the English Proficiency Test on <u>13 August 2024</u>. Those who obtain satisfactory results in the test may test out of some or all of the English language courses. However, students who successfully test out are required to take additional Free Elective(s) to make up the credits. Please check the "Course Requirements and Test Out Information for English Language Courses" for academic year 2023/2024 as a reference: (<u>https://reg.um.edu.mo/current-students/curriculum-model/ug-curriculum-model/languages-and-skills/</u>). The 2024/2025 information sheet will be announced in early August.

Students who have obtained satisfactory results in recognized public examination such as IELTS, TOFEL iBT, IGCSE, etc., as specified in the "Course Requirements and Test Out Information for English Language Courses" are eligible to apply for testing out. To do so, please submit your applications via email at <u>registry@um.edu.mo</u> on or before 31 July 2024. In the subject line of your email, please state "Application for testing out of English Language Course(s)". Remember to attach all relevant documents and include your personal information in the email.

You should have received an email from the Registry (<u>reg-noreply@um.edu.mo</u>) containing important information about your student account. Please keep it secure and follow the instructions provided in the email to activate your student account **before the Test (13 August)**. You will be required to log in to your student account to access the Test.

More information about the English Proficiency Test will be released on the webpage of the English Language Centre (<u>https://fah.um.edu.mo/english-language-centre</u>) in early August. <u>Please be reminded</u> to bring along your "Offer of Admission" and valid ID card / passport for the Test on 13 August.
