Test Out Requirements

A student can test out of some or all of the English language courses if he/she obtains any of the following examination scores/qualifications:

- English score (JE01) of Joint Admission Examination for Macao Four Higher Education Institutions (JAE) at 870 or above
- IELTS (International English Language Testing System) of 5.0 or above
- TOEFL (Test Of English as a Foreign Language) of 417 or above
- TOEFL iBT (internet-Based Test of TOEFL) of 35 or above
- TOEIC (Test Of English for International Communication) of 600 or above
- English language score of IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) of grade B or above
- Other evidence of language proficiency (to be considered on a case-by-case basis)
