－IELTS（International English Language Testing System）of 5.0 or above
－TOEFL（Test Of English as a Foreign Language）of 417 or above
－TOEFL iBT（internet－Based Test of TOEFL）of 35 or above
－TOEIC（Test Of English for International Communication）of 600 or above
－English language score of IGCSE（International General Certificate of Secondary Education）of grade B or above
－Other evidence of language proficiency（to be considered on a case－by－case basis）
