

## <u>Test Out Information for "Languages and Skills" Courses – Portuguese Language Course</u> (Applicable from Academic Year 2017/2018 onwards)

## **Portuguese Language Course:**

PORT1000 – Portuguese Language I - Introductory Portuguese (3 credits, 3 lecture hours per week)

A student can test out of the Portuguese language course if he/she obtains any of the following qualifications:

- Portuguese A (P101) or B (P102) score of UM admission examination of 400 or above
- Portuguese A (JP01) or B (JP02) score of Joint Admission Examination for Macao Four Higher Education Institutions (JAE) of 450 or above
- Completion of Summer Course of Portuguese Language and Culture (60 lecture hours in total) offered by the Department of Portuguese of University of Macau
- CAPLE (Centro de Avaliação de Português Língua Estrangeira or Centre for Evaluation of Portuguese as a Foreign Language) or CEPLE-Bras (Certificado de Proficiência em Língua Portuguesa para Estrangeiros or Certificate of Proficiency in Portuguese for Foreigners) certificate of level A2 or above
- IPOR (Instituto Português do Oriente) certificate of level A1 or above (2-semester general course or 90-hour intensive course)
- Graduate certificate of Escola Portuguesa de Macau
- Other evidence of language proficiency (to be considered on a case-by-case basis)

This test out information is not applicable to the students majoring in Portuguese Studies. Students majoring in Portuguese Studies are required to complete the course, **Portuguese Language and Culture I**, to fulfil the Chinese/Portuguese language requirement in Languages and Skills.

## Notes:

- 1. Students are required to make up the test-out credits by taking more Free Electives (FE).
- 2. Test-out course will be recorded as a waived course with 'CW' grade in students' academic records.
